Whether you're travelling abroad this summer or staying closer to home, you'll be able to visit The Coro and explore the world through craft and imagination. No passport required – just creativity!

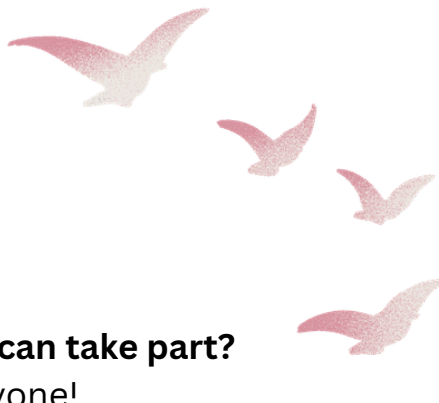
### What can you make?
